



6 Days/ 5 Nights

Lake Manyara, Ngorongoro Crater, Serengeti and Tarangire National Park

Day 1: Moshi to **Lake Manyara National Park**

After breakfast, we pick you up at your hotel and drive to Lake Manyara National Park. It is a lovely park with the shallow soda lake being a haven for flamingoes. It is a favorite park for bird-watchers with over 300 migratory bird species. The park also is known for its tree climbing lions. There are also numerous baboons, giraffe, impala, hippo and elephant. Along the way, you will get a chance to pass through some small towns and rural areas get a glimpse of ordinary life in Tanzania. Upon arrival at Lake Manyara National Park, we will proceed on a game drive. The game viewing will continue until mid afternoon, when we will travel into Ngorongoro Conservation Area (NCA) where we will have dinner and overnight at campsite/lodge. Note: Overnights are not permitted inside of the crater. All accommodations are outside the crater, most are near the crater rim. This is a cold location since there is some altitude (7,500 ft or 2286m). Even a knit cap and light gloves may feel welcome since it also tends to be windy.

Drive time: 3-4hrs - Moshi- Lake Manyara

Drive time: 1.5 - 2 hours Lake Manyara - NCA

Meals: box lunch and dinner.

Day 2: **Ngorongoro Conservation Area**

Early morning breakfast then we will descend down the steep crater walls for game viewing. The crater has a very high density of animals and a wide variety are present (including rhino). But the crater is not very large, just 20km in diameter. So in 4 - 5 hours all will be seen. Afterwards we will ascend the crater floor making our way west, exiting NCA and into the Serengeti. Game viewing in the Serengeti then we make our way to our evening accommodations inside of the Serengeti.

Drive time: 3 hrs Crater - Serengeti
Meals: Breakfast, box lunch and dinner.

Day 3: Serengeti National Park

Full day game viewing in the Serengeti. What portion of the Serengeti you stay in will be dependent on the time of the year that you are traveling. This will be determined well before the start of your safari. Overnight inside of the Serengeti.

Activity: Game drive full day
Meals: Breakfast, box lunch and dinner

Day 4: Serengeti National Park

Full day game viewing inside of the Serengeti. Depending on the time of the year will determine exactly where the guide will take you for game viewing. Overnight inside of the Serengeti.

Activity: Game drive full day
Meals: Breakfast, box lunch and dinner

Day 5: Serengeti National Park to Mto Wa mbu

After breakfast, we set out to explore of the Serengeti as we exit the park and across NCA (but not through the crater) to Tarangire National Park. Our accommodations will be outside of the park.

Drive time: Dependent on the time of the year
Meals: breakfast, boxed lunch and dinner

Day 6: Tarangire National Park to Moshi/JRO

Early morning game drive inside of Tarangire with picnic Lunch, afterwards we will continue game viewing as we eventually make our way out of the park and return to Moshi or Kilimanjaro Airport. - if you have a late afternoon or evening flight it is quite convenient to be dropped off at the airport on the way back from the safari.

Drive hrs Tarangire - JRO (3 hours) /Moshi (3.5 - 4 hrs)
Meals: Breakfast and box lunch

Tour price includes:

All park fees and emergency evacuation insurance; drinking water; unlimited mileage in a 4x4 vehicle with pop-up roof for game viewing; English-speaking guide; full board accommodation or camping facilities, cook and three meals a day while on safari; birds and animal field guide book; a pair of binoculars; government taxes.

Price does not include:

Personal items (e.g. cameras, visa, travel insurance); alcoholic drinks; tips for your guide and cook. Industry recommendations are \$15 a day to the cook and \$20 a day to your guide divided by everyone in the vehicle. Pre/post-accommodation (booking is available upon request).

Suggestions on things to bring:

Extra binoculars, camera, sunglasses, hat and sunscreen, mosquito repellent, warm clothes for your early morning in Ngorongoro Crater, cool comfortable clothes for during the days.
